I read yet another interesting article entitled, "A Survey of Youth Sports Finds Winning Isn't the Only Thing," and I wanted to share some of the contents with you.

Some 21 years ago scientists at Michigan State polled 28,000 young athletes around the country and asked, "Why do you play sports?" Recently, a 15 year old high school student heard about the survey and decided to do his own in his hometown of Darien, Connecticut. He polled about 800 local youth at the YMCA.

His recent findings were strikingly similar to those of 21 years ago. The top answer to the question was, "to have fun."
