Indiana Statewide Testing for Educational Progress (ISTEP) began today at CKS. This annual test is given to grades 3-8 as a means of measuring and tracking progress of individual students over time. It is based on Indiana academic standards. When a student goes to high school it turns into a Graduation Qualifying Exam (GQE). For this reason and others, it is important for students to do their very best during ISTEP testing.
